University of Wyoming Scholarship Awarding Policy and Process Changes

Effective beginning for new students entering in the Spring 2010 and Fall 2010

AWARDING TIMELINE

Timeline of Fall Scholarship Awarding

December 1 Students wishing to be considered for Trustees' Scholars or WUE awards required to have a completed application on file with UW Admissions.

Wyoming Scholars and Hoyt scholarships will continue to be awarded to admitted students per scholarship policy until May 1st (assuming available funding).

February 1 Deadline for college and department scholarship applications. Colleges and departments can choose to have earlier deadline.

RESIDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Resident New Freshman Scholarships

Wyoming Scholars Award

Resident students with a 3.50 cumulative GPA (unweighted on a 4.0 scale) and a 25 composite ACT will receive \$1,000 annually.

Students receiving this scholarship must maintain full-time, continuous enrollment and must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA (to be evaluated at the end of Spring term each year). This scholarship is available for a maximum of 8 semesters (not available for use during Summer term).

Trustees' Scholars Award

On February 1, the top 75 admitted new resident freshmen will be awarded the Trustees' Scholars Award. This award provides scholarship dollars equal to the cost of tuition, fees, room and board at 18 credit hours per semester and at the double occupancy rate in the UW Residence Halls. These 75 students will be chosen based on academic transcripts and test scores on file with the UW Admissions Office. GPA, test scores and academic rigor of college preparatory work will be considered in the selection of these top students. Students wishing to be considered must have a complete application for admission on file by December 1st.

Students receiving this scholarship must maintain full-time, continuous enrollment and must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA (to be evaluated at the end of Spring term each year). This scholarship is available for a maximum of 8 semesters (not available for use during Summer term).

College, Department and Talent-based Scholarships

All students may pursue college and department-based scholarships according to individual scholarship eligibility requirements. These scholarships will be in addition to any eligible Wyoming Scholars' and Hathaway merit awards. Colleges and departments will be notified of cases where students qualify for Hathaway need-based awards so that resources can be maximized.

Resident New Transfer Scholarships

Hoyt

Resident students transferring with an associate's degree and a 3.40 cumulative college GPA will receive the Hoyt Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 annually. This award is available regardless of the student's Hathaway eligibility.

Students receiving this scholarship must maintain full-time, continuous enrollment and must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA (to be evaluated at the end of Spring term each year). This scholarship is available for a maximum of 4 semesters (not available for use during Summer term).
